

FAQ - Hobie Europeans Ustka

1. What clothing is recommended for the conditions of the Ustka water area?

Answer: The water temperature during the regatta period usually ranges from 19 to 21 degrees Celsius. We recommend using a neoprene wetsuit minimum 4:3 with long sleeves. A drysuit is not necessary.

2. What are the opening hours of the footbridge connecting Port Ustka with the eastern beach?

Answer: The footbridge is open for pedestrian traffic during the following hours:

- From 07:00 to 01:00, every full hour for 20 minutes.
- *The footbridge is closed when wind speeds exceed 10 m/s (36 km/h).

3. Where can cars be parked?

Answer: In Port Ustka, there will be free parking spaces designated for the personal cars of regatta participants. We recommend taking an identifier from the regatta office during registration.

Parking on the western side is paid, and fees may vary depending on the location. Prices are approximately 5-6 PLN per hour. The daily fee for parking in the zone is about 50 PLN. Fees in the zone will apply from Monday to Friday between 9:00 and 21:00.

*Attention drivers: An additional fee for unpaid parking is 200 PLN.

4. Where can Campers be parked?

Answer: Special parking spaces are available in Harbor. Offering a unique experience right by the waterfront.

- 29 spots in total (including 14 with electricity)
- €40/day with electricity | €35/day without electricity
- Sanitary facilities & showers included
- No gray water disposal (the port is not a professional camper site)
- Temporary power recharging option available for spots without direct electricity access
