## Port Safety Regulations - Message from the Rescue Supervisor

- 1. Each training entry and exit before the start of the European Championships must be reported by the coach to the port captaincy on VHF channel 12 or by calling the phone number 0048 59 814 44 30
- 2. When the port is open (pedestrian bridge folded for pedestrian traffic), under no circumstances should you enter the waterway in the leeward of the eastern pier (right side). However, when the port is closed (pedestrian bridge extended for pedestrian traffic), you can tack across the entire width.
- 3. During the championships, every individual return to the port must be reported to the nearest regatta support motorboat.
- 4. During the regattas (at the beginning and end of races), a motorboat will be stationed in front of the harbor heads to direct the traffic.
- 5. Every coaching motorboat is obliged to provide assistance in the event of a health and life-threatening situation after informing the safety supervisor beforehand.
- 6. Swimming under the pedestrian bridge is prohibited. In exceptional life-threatening situations, one should report to the rescue supervisor.
- 7. VHF channel 77 Contact with the rescue supervisor.
- 8. All motorboat helmsman must present accreditation and must compulsorily provide the motorboat's registration documents as well as the motorboat helmsman's qualifications to the regatta office during registration
- 9. The general safety rules applicable in maritime ports
