Registration and Check In Information.

- When you arrive at the venue go to the registration desks located on the lower floor of the clubhouse.
- If you are bringing your own boat drop it off at the entrance to the park and take it in to your designated country area then go to check in
- When you check in you will receive an ID card, cooler bag with a drink bottle, t-shirt, cap, race bib, sunscreen and other information. Please wear your ID card when at the venue.
- Once you have checked in and if you have chartered a Bic move on to the Charter counter and sign off your charter and receive your allocated sail.
- After check in go to the boat park and set up your boat.
- All Sails are to have country flags and advertising stickers applied.
 If you have a charter boat these should have already been applied for you.
 All others take your sail to the tent where they will be applied for you.

If arriving with a Bic on a trailer, after unloading please park across Laurence Street on the side of the road that leads around the Manly Park. There is an area to leave trailers in the park however it is not secure and it would require a <u>wheel clamp</u>. It is preferable to remove trailers from the venue.

For those of you who are in New Zealand for the first time be aware that the sun is very strong and sunburn is a common occurrence if you don't use sunscreen. There is some in your pack and more is available from the race office.

As the event is in support of **<u>not</u>** using single use plastic bottles, competitors will have two drink bottles so you may have water in one and a health drink in the other, health drinks are not provided. There is a water station to refill your bottles located near the Clubhouse.

There will not be any access to the boat park during Christmas Day.

Please put any rubbish in the rubbish containers located in and around the boat park.































Boat Park

The boat park is designed to fit everyone in a secured area. The yellow arrows indicate the passage ways to move to and from the beach so it is important to put your boat away and not leave it in the areas showing the yellow arrows. It is also important to keep the boats in the boxes so it looks neat and tidy. The tent is for some shelter from the sun and to leave bags during the day.

The boxes will be painted on the grass so it is easy to know where to park your boat.
