The Gods of Olympus

Greek Mythology

After the battle of the Titans the world divided into three parts, between the three brothers, Zeus, Poseidon, and <u>Hades</u> or Plutonas. Zeus took the sky, Poseidon the sea and Hades took the underworld which is also called Hades.

The land and Olympus were not given to anybody. Zeus was the most powerful among the gods. His brothers, sisters and kids acquired different positions. There were many gods and goddesses. The most important though were the six gods and six goddesses of Mount Olympus, also called the Olympian gods:

The Gods

- <u>Zeus</u> = $\Delta \iota \alpha \varsigma / Z \epsilon \upsilon \varsigma$. The king of all gods and humans.
- <u>Poseidon</u> = $\Pi \circ \sigma \varepsilon \circ \delta \circ v \alpha \varsigma$. The god of the sea.
- <u>Apollo</u> = $A\pi \delta \lambda \omega v \alpha \zeta$. The God of the sun, music, and divination.
- <u>Hermes</u> = $E\rho\mu\eta\varsigma$. The messenger of the gods.
- <u>Ares</u> = $A\rho\eta\varsigma$. The god of war.
- <u>Hephaestus</u> = $H\phi\alpha\iota\sigma\tau\circ\varsigma$. The god of fire and the craftsman of the gods. He made Zeus' thunderbolts.

The Goddesses

- <u>Hera</u> = $H \rho \alpha$. Zeus' wife, the Queen of the gods.
- <u>Athena</u> = $A\theta\eta\nu\dot{\alpha}$. Zeus' daughter, goddess of wisdom.
- <u>Aphrodite</u> = Αφροδίτη. The goddess of beauty. She came out from the foam of the sea on a beach in Cyprus.
- <u>Demeter</u> = $\Delta \eta \mu \eta \tau \rho \alpha$. The goddess of agriculture.
- <u>Artemis</u> = $A \rho \tau \epsilon \mu \eta$. The goddess of hunting.
- <u>Hestia</u> = $E\sigma\tau i\alpha$. The goddess of the home and the family.

Other Gods

There were other gods that did not live on Mount Olympus. Some of them are:

- <u>Hades</u> = $A\delta\eta\varsigma$ or $\Pi\lambda\circ\dot{\tau}\omega\nu\alpha\varsigma$. The god of the underworld, Zeus' brother.
- <u>Dionysus</u> = $\Delta i \delta v \upsilon \sigma \sigma \varsigma$. Son of Zeus, the god of wine.
- <u>Pan</u> = $\Pi \dot{\alpha} \nu \alpha \zeta$. Son of Hermes, god of the shepherds and the flocks.
